SIGNALS

Warning	Class Flag:	1 sound	3 minutes before starting signal
Preparatory	P, I, Z, with I, or black flag:	1 sound	2 " " " "
One-minute	Preparatory Flag removed:	1 sound	1 " " " "
Start	Class flag removed:	1 sound	0

** The warning signal for any succeeding class may be made at the starting signal of a preceding class **

1. SIGNALS:

1.1 Signals will be made from the Race Committee Boat.

2. RACE SCHEDULE:

2.1 ANY CHANGE to the above starting order shall be announced at the Skipper's Meeting and posted. The Warning for the first race will be at 1057 hrs.

3. THE COURSE:

- 3.1 Appendix I to these Sailing Instructions includes *Course Sheet*.
- 3.2 Courses shall consist of a windward mark (W), reaching mark (R), and a leeward mark (L) with various combinations as shown in appendix I.
- 3.3 Race courses will be displayed by the Race Committee by a placard displaying the course number simultaneously with the Class Flag. All marks will be rounded to port.

4. **MARKS:**

- 4.1 Marks of the course will be inflatable spheres.
- 4.2 The Start/Finish line will be a line between an inflatable sphere and an orange flag on the port side of the Race Committee Boat.

5. **START:**

- 5.1 Boats whose preparatory signal has not been made shall keep clear of the starting area as well as all boats whose preparatory signal has been made.
- 5.2 The Starting/Finishing line is restricted except for those boats preparing to start, starting a race, or for those boats finishing a race.

6. **TIME LIMIT:**

- 6.1 The time limit for the first boat to finish in each starting class is forty-five (45) minutes from her start. Boats failing to finish within thirty (30) minutes after the first boat in her class finishes or after the time limit, whichever is later, will be scored "DNF".

7. **SCORING:**

- 7.1 Three races are scheduled. One race must be completed to constitute the series. There are no throw outs

8. **PROTESTS:**

- 8.1.1 Protests shall be written. They shall be filed at the Encinal Yacht Club with the Regatta PRO. Protest time will end one hour after the Race Committee Boat docks.
- 8.1.2 Protest notices will be posted at the Encinal Yacht Club within ten (10) minutes following the protest time limit.

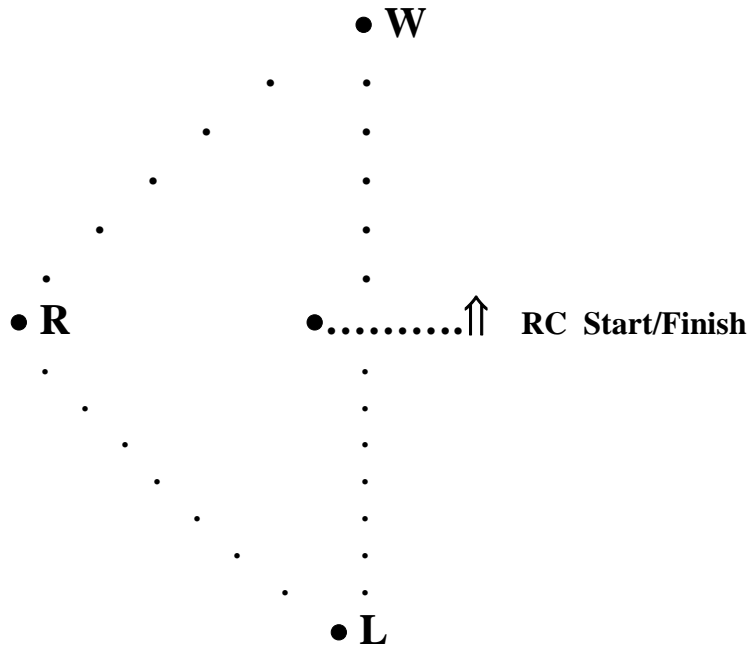
